We are looking for postdoctoral researchers who are able to take a strong leading role in data analysis and in the construction of the new silicon detector.

The positions are for two years and available immediately. The candidate will be employed by Utrecht University and the positions are funded via NWO. You will receive a competitive salary, and an additional net allowance during a stay at CERN.
